

## Activating Mobile Web Pages in Atrium

Atrium Mobile Web Pages are now visible on mobile devices such as Android phones, Kindle Fire, iPhones, and iPads. These pages are simplified forms of Atrium's OPAC for ease of navigation and quick browsing. To enable your library's Mobile Web Pages, do the following:

1. **Log On** to the Librarian side of Atrium.
2. Click **Administration** on the Top Menu Bar.
3. Click **OPAC** from the menu options.
4. Click **Settings** (blue link).
5. Scroll down to the Mobile Settings area, then click **Yes** next to Show Link to Mobile.



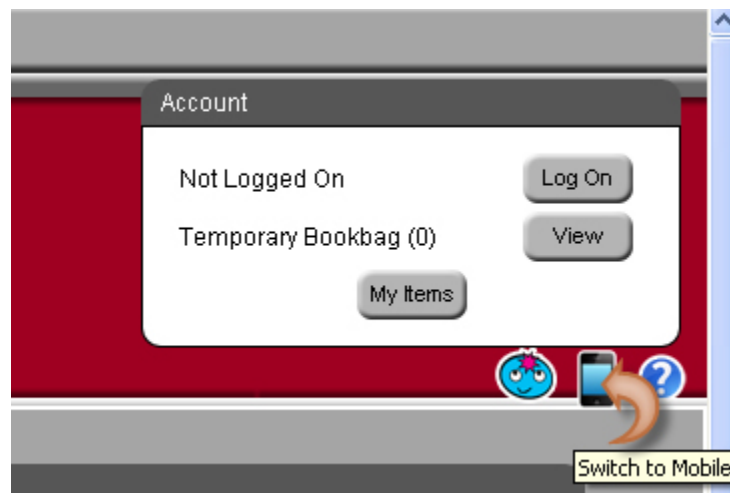

6. When finished, scroll to the bottom of the page and click the **Save Changes** (button).

Once your changes have been applied, go to your OPAC.



You will see a Mobile phone icon located just under the Account widget (as shown above).

**Note:** If you don't see the icon (shown above) on the home page for your library's OPAC, you will need to refresh your browser.

## "Atrium on the Go" Mobile Apps

Book Systems' native mobile apps are also available for free. Your patrons can download them for Android devices from Google Play and from the iTunes App Store for Apple devices. Here's some information to help you get started. 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### Google Play for Android apps

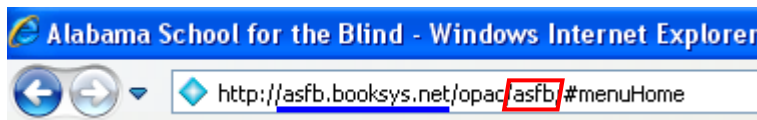
#### Requirements:

- Android version 2.1 or higher.
- Internet connection enabled on the mobile device.
- A local library that uses the Atrium library automation software, version 8.1.5 or higher.
- Built-in camera/scanner with auto-focus is required to use the scan ISBN or Barcode feature.

Go to the Google Play store (<https://play.google.com/store>) and search for "Atrium". Select "Atrium on the Go" and view the information or choose to Install the app.

When opening the "Atrium on the Go" app, you must enter the settings to connect to a library's catalog.

- **Server** – is for the TCP/IP address of your Atrium server. Insert the numbered or named address (as shown underlined below).



- **Port** – insert **80** unless specified otherwise, i.e., http://asfb.booksys.net:8080 and 8080 would be the port.
- **Library** – insert the text as it appears in the Atrium server address between opac/ and /#menuHome (as shown inside the parallelogram above).

You can also use the "Scan QR for Setting" to make it easier for your patrons to setup the app.

All you need to do is generate a QR Code using any QR Code generator (For example: <http://begrious.com/qr-code-generator/>) and create a QR Code using the full link to your library's OPAC (For example: http://asfb.booksys.net/opac/asfb/). You can print out or download the graphic image created by the QR Code generator and embed the image on your library's website.

While on the settings dialog, use the Scan QR for Settings (appears underneath Connect to Library) and scan the QR Code you've created. This will automatically fill in the **Server**, **Port**, and **Library** information.

Once the settings are configured, it will enable patrons to scan an ISBN or Barcode and perform a lookup by that criteria. Otherwise, they can choose Connect to Library and use the normal search features or Log On to their patron account.

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## iTunes Store for iPad & iPhone apps

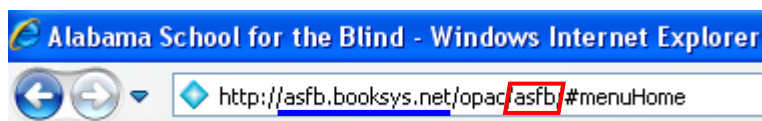
### Requirements:

- Compatible with iPhone 3GS, iPhone 4, iPhone 4S, iPhone 5, iPod touch (3rd generation), iPod touch (4th generation), iPod touch (5th generation), and iPads
- Requires iOS 5.0 or later
- Internet connection enabled on the mobile device.
- A local library that uses the Atrium library automation software, version 8.1.5 or higher.
- Built-in camera/scanner with auto-focus is required to use the scan ISBN or Barcode feature.

Go to the iTunes store from your mobile device and search for "Atrium". Select "Atrium on the Go" and view the information or choose to Install the appropriate app.

When opening the Atrium on the Go app, you must enter the settings to connect to a library's catalog.

- **Server** – is for the TCP/IP address of your Atrium server. Insert the numbered or named address (as shown underlined below).



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
